## Kendall County / City of Boerne Events and Farmer's Market Guidelines

1. The event coordinator or his/her designees will provide to the Health Department a list of all food vendors attending the event/farmers market.
2. Food vendors not operating under the cottage rules are required to provide a copy of food handler cards and return the signed temporary permit form.
3. Fees must be paid before the temporary permits are issued at least two working days prior to the event or market. Payment can be made by check, cash or money order payable to Kendall County. Cottage Food Vendors are exempt from paying a fee.
4. Vendors operating under the Cottage Production Rules must comply with the state regulations found at [Texas Cottage Food Production | Texas DSHS](#). A temporary permit form is not required for food vendors operating under the Cottage Production Rules. The Kendall County Health Department requires a food handlers to have a current food handlers certificate according the Texas Department of State Health rules.
5. Food vendors operating a mobile food vehicle at the event/farmers market will be required to obtain a fire safety permit from the Kendall County Fire Marshal before a temporary health permit is issued. Contact the Fire Marshal's office at 830-249-3721.
6. Temporary health permit fee is \$25.00.
